## [Notes]

- Replacement days in each quarter are scheduled in order to make up the number of class days for each day of the week, so classes on the replaced day of the week are to be held. (e.g. 5/8 is a Thursday, but the class will be held on Monday's timetable because it is marked as "Monday".)
- In principle, no classes other than the "Intensive Course" will be offered during the Intensive Course Period. The class schedule for the intensive course period will be posted separately.
- In principle, only English-language placement tests (including additional tests) are held on English-language placement test dates, but in some cases, classroom examinations for online courses, etc., may also be held.
- Even where classes are scheduled, all or some classes may be cancelled due to university events, festivals, etc., so please check bulletins etc. Also, classes, make-up classes, examinations, etc. may be held even on days scheduled as holidays in special circumstances.
